**Katie Howe** will graduate in May 2024 with a Bachelor’s of Science degree in Biology from K-State. She is continuing to vet school there.

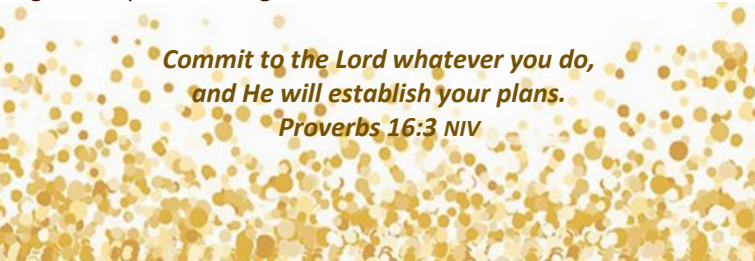
**Stuart Luckman** graduated in December 2023 with a Bachelor’s degree in Philosophy and in Political Science from KU.
